

EXTRACTION OF TEETH LEADS TO BONE LOSS OVER TIME, YOU CAN SLOW THIS DOWN BY HAVING REGULAR DENTURE RELINES.

Relines prevent accelerated bone loss.

Gums will recede over time and a poor fitting denture will result in accelerated reduction of bone

Relines are Required every Two to Three Years for Optimal health of gums and bone structure.

SINGLE TOOTH EXTRACTION

Tooth Loss leads to shrinking gum and bone loss over time.

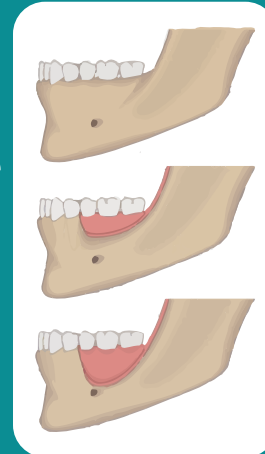
A single Anterior Partial well fitting slows the rate of reduction.



SEVERAL TEETH EXTRACTION

When several teeth are extracted gums and bone of the whole quadrant are effected.

A well fitted Partial Denture will ensure a slowing in the rate of reduction.



ALL TEETH EXTRACTED

•When a Full Maxillary or Mandibular extraction occurs significant reduction in gums and bone are inevitable.

•In order to slow the progression as you age, allowing an optimal fit well into your later years Relines are **STRONGLY** advised every 2 - 3 years.
